## ANGEL FOOD MINISTRY

We have been part of the Angel Food Ministry for three months. Each month we have served more people. Twenty-six boxes were ordered in September. The \$25.00 box has enough food for a family of four for a week. This really helps the food budgets. Genny Ramsey is here on the last Thursday of the month between 1:00 and 3:00 to take orders. The food is usually delivered on the second Saturday. Someone takes a truck downtown and picks up our order. The truck is back here by 9:30 on the distribution Saturday.

For that distribution day we need:

2 people to pick-up food at St Paul's Episcopal Church Atlanta at 6:30 am  
3 people to hand-out orders at the church between 9:30-11:00 am
